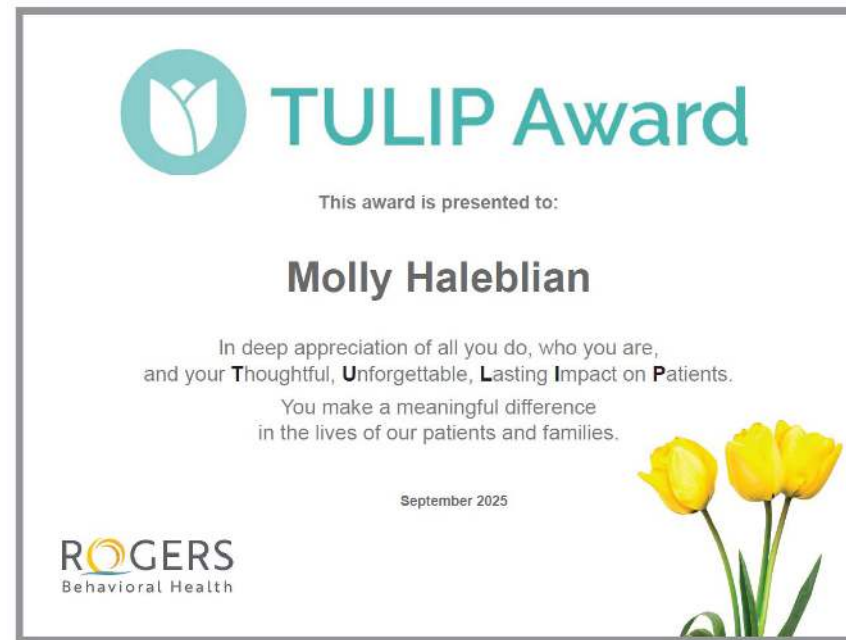


About the TULIP Award
